Class - 06

1. Corroborate (verb)

Trick: Collaborate

Meaning: Establish or strength as with new evidence or facts

Synonyms: Certify, confirm, Support

Antonyms: Contradict, Deny, Disclaim

Sentence: Recent research seems to corroborate his theory.

2. Rife (adj.)

Trick: Rifle

Meaning: Most frequent or common

Synonyms: Abounding, abundant, crowded

Antonyms: Barren, Empty, Devoid

Sentence: Corruption and money smuggling are very common before the election.

3. Conundrum (Noun)

Trick: Koun + Drum

Meaning: A difficult problem or hard to understand

Synonyms: Closed book, enigma, puzzle, secret

Antonyms: Obviousness, Solution, Clarification

Sentence: The administration is facing a familiar conundrum.

4. Exalt (adj.)

Trick: Excellent

Meaning: to make somebody rise to a higher rank / to praise somebody

Synonyms: Aggrandize, Deify, Elevate, Magnify

Antonyms: Decry, Detract, Minimize

Sentence: She thanked the teacher to exalt her.

5. Ransack (verb)

Trick: Ran + See

Meaning: To look thoroughly or stealing or Damaging

Synonyms: search, Scour, Go through

Antonyms: Hide, abandon, Ignore

Sentence: I ransacked the house looking for my purse.



6. Inimitable (Adj.)

Trick: In (Not) + Imitable

Meaning: too good to be satisfactory copied by anyone

Synonyms: Incomparable, Matchless, Only

Antonyms: Comparable, Indistinctive

Sentence: He delivered the speech in his own inimitable style.

7. Erstwhile (adj.)

Trick:

Meaning: Belonging to some prior time

Synonyms: Former, Late, Once

Antonyms: Contemporary, Current, Ongoing

Sentence: His erstwhile friends turned against him.

8. Prelude (Noun)

Trick: Conclude (Opposite)

Meaning: Something that serves as a preceding event or introduces what follows

Synonyms: Overture, Preamble, Prologue

Antonyms: Postscript, Aftermath, Close

Sentence: The prelude to the musical composition is very long



9. Esoteric (adj.)

Trick: Historic

Meaning : Understood by Small number of people

Synonyms: Abstruse, Arcane, Difficult, Hard

Antonyms: Easy, facile, Comprehensible

Sentence: Some words are esoteric for his dictionary.



10. Quid Pro Quo

Meaning: An exchange of goods or services

Synonyms: Barter, Commutation, Back and forth

Antonyms: Inconsideration, Tactlessness

Sentence: There is a quid pro quo for everything in politics.
