Polarisation in times of dispossession

# 1. Dispossession (Noun)

**Trick : Dispose**

**Meaning:** The action of depriving someone of land, property or other possession

**Synonyms:** Deprivation, Loss & forfeit

**Antonyms:** Acquisition, Gain & Possession

**Sentence:** We are seeing dispossession on a massive scale.

## 2. Rhetoric (Noun)

**Trick :** Right Oral Skill

**Meaning:** Art of effective speaking (वक्रपटुता)

**Synonyms:** Bombast, Oratory, wind

**Antonyms:** Quiet, Conciseness

**Sentence:** What is required is immediate action, not rhetoric.



### 3. Culmination (Noun)

**Trick:** Termination

**Meaning :** End point or final stage (समापन)

**Synonyms:** Acme, Apex, Climax

**Antonyms:** Bottom, Nadir

**Sentence:** The show marked the culmination of months of hard work.



## 4. Aberrant (Adj)

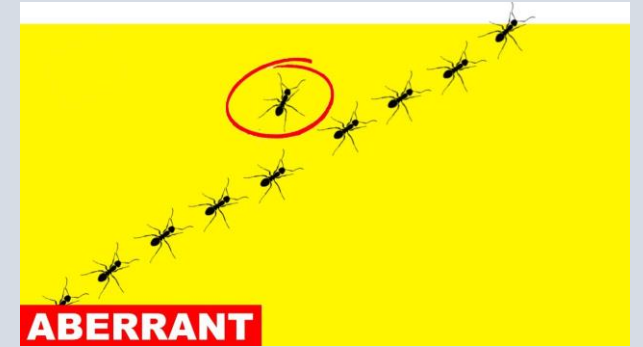
**Trick:** Beer + Ant

**Meaning:** Departing from an accepted standard (धर्मपथ से हटनेवाला)

**Synonyms:** Deviant, Abnormal, Anomalous

**Antonyms:** Usual, Familiar, run of the mill

**Sentence:** His aberrant behavior requires an explanation



## 5. Buoyant (Adj.)

**Trick:** Buy + want

**Meaning:** Cheerful & Optimistic (प्रसन्नचित्त)

**Synonyms:** Cheerful, Happy, Sanguine

**Antonyms:** Lethargic, Sluggish, Torpid

**Sentence:** Demand for the product is buoyant.

## 6. Disdain (Noun)

**Trick:** Wisden

**Meaning:** the feeling that somebody is not good enough to be respected. (तिरस्कार)

**Synonyms:** Contempt, Hate, Execration

**Antonyms:** Acceptance, tolerance

**Sentence:** He turned his head away in disdain.





## 7. Exacerbate (verb)

**Trick:** Exam + Cer + ate

**Meaning:** Make worse (खराब करना)

**Synonyms:** Aggravate, Complicate

**Antonyms:** Alleviate, Ease

**Sentence:** I don't want to exacerbate the situation.



## 8. Abominable (Adj.)

**Trick:** Boman Irani

**Meaning:** Causing Moral Revulsion/ Very bad

**Synonyms:** Abhorrent, Appalling, awful

**Antonyms:** Brackish, Unpleasant

**Sentence:** This cruel treatment of prisoners was abominable.

## 9. Abstain (verb)

**Trick:** Ab + stay (out)

**Meaning:** Refrain from something

**Synonyms:** Decline, refuse, reject

**Antonyms:** Choose, Decide, Opt

**Sentence:** He took a vow to abstain from Alcohol

## 10. Coherent (adj.)

**Trick:** Oh Her rent

**Meaning :** Logical & Consistent

**Synonyms:** Analytics, Consequent

**Antonyms :** Eristic, Misleading

**Sentence:** The government lacks a coherent economic policy.
