# 1. Bombastic (adj.)

**Trick:** Bombs

**Meaning:** High- sounding but with little meaning (आडंबरपूर्ण)

**Synonyms:** Inflated, flatulent, Gassy, Elevated

**Antonyms:** Eloquent, well- spoken, Direct

**Sentence:** His **bombastic** style made him unpopular.



## 2. Venerate (verb)

**Trick:** Vanar Ram

**Meaning :** Regard with great respect  
सम्मान करना, आदर करना, पूजना

**Synonyms:** Reverence, Worship, Respect

**Antonyms:** Disrespect

**Sentence:** Ayodhya is one of the most **venerated** place in India.



### 3. Ample (Adj.)

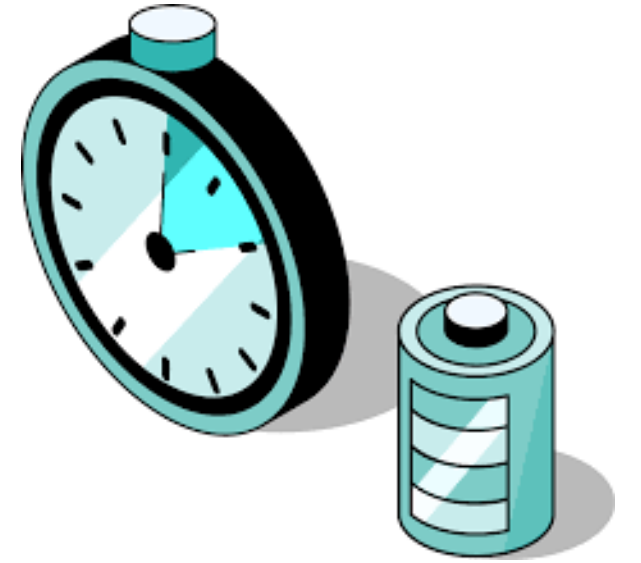
**Trick :** Temple

**Meaning:** Enough or more than enough  
(प्रचुर)

**Synonyms:** Abundant, Surplus, Bountiful

**Antonyms:** Deficient, Insufficient

**Sentence:** You will have ample time for questions later.



## 4. Formidable (adj.)

**Trick:** For + Me + Devil

**Meaning:** Extremely impressive in strength or excellence (भयंकर)

**Synonyms:** Alarming, Dreadful, Daunting

**Antonyms:** Calming, Comforting, relaxing

**Sentence:** In a debate Raj was a formidable opponent.



## 5. Squabble (Noun)

**Trick:** Sqaure + Quarrel

**Meaning:** noisy quarrel about something trivial (झगड़ा)

**Synonyms:** Quarrel, Argument, Fight

**Antonyms:** Accept, Assent, Agree, Consent

**Sentence:** He always like to squabble with others.



## 6. Disparaging (Adj.)

**Trick :** Dis + Para is ajeeb

**Meaning:** Expressive of low opinion  
(उपेक्षा करनेवाला)

**Synonyms:** Belittling, Contemptuous, Decrying

**Antonyms:** Commendatory, Complimentary, Laudatory

**Sentence:** She made some disparaging remarks  
about the neighbours.





## 7. Abdicate (Verb)

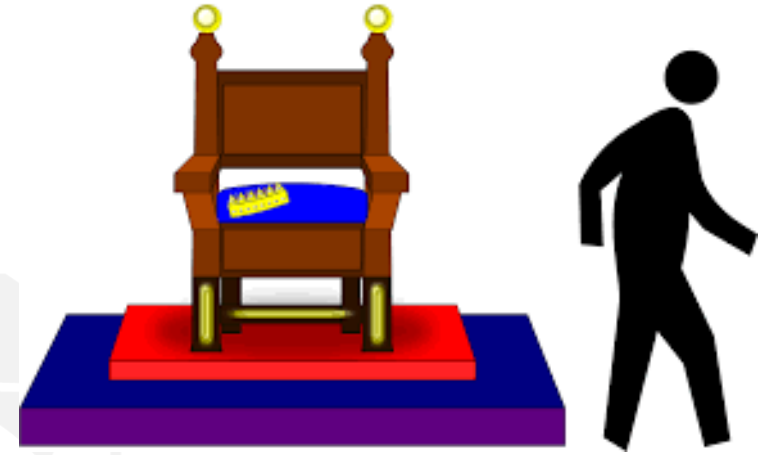
**Trick:** Ab de de Cat

**Meaning:** Renounce or to give up (त्यागना)

**Synonyms:** Resign, Retire, Quit

**Antonyms:** Appropriate, Assume, Claim

**Sentence:** He was forced to abdicate his seat after failing to prove majority.



## 8. Ransack (verb)

**Trick:** Ran + See

**Meaning:** To look thoroughly or stealing or Damaging

**Synonyms:** search, Scour, Go through

**Antonyms:** Hide, abandon, Ignore

**Sentence:** I ransacked the house looking for my purse.



## 9. Persistent

**Trick:** Purse + Tent

**Meaning:** Continuing to exist or occur over a prolonged period (दृढ़)

**Synonyms:** Certain, Determined, Firm

**Antonyms:** Quitting, Surrendering, Hesitant

**Sentence:** This Covid grew more persistent until it never stopped.



## 10. Knee- jerk

**Trick:**

**Meaning:** Made automatically without any serious thought

**Synonyms:** Natural, Reflex, Simple, Unintentional

**Antonyms:** Calculated, Deliberately, Intend

**Sentence:** It was knee-jerk reaction on her part.
