# 1. Replicate (verb)

**Trick :** Duplicate

**Meaning:** Reproduce or make an exact copy of

**Synonyms:** Clone, Imitate, Reiterate, Remake

**Antonyms:** Create, Initiate, Invent, Originate

**Sentence:** If the virus cannot replicate itself, it cannot cause illness.

## 2. Inflammation (Noun)

**Trick:** Flame

**Meaning:** A condition in which a part of body becomes red, swollen & painful

**Synonyms:** Sore, Discomfort, Hurt, Injury

**Antonyms:** Comfort, Ease

**Sentence:** Aspirin reduces pain & inflammation.

### 3. Ambiguous (Adj.)

**Trick:** AmBI + Guess

**Meaning:** Having more than one possible meaning

**Synonyms:** Arcane, Uncertain, Becloud

**Antonyms:** Comprehensible, Legible, Certain

**Sentence:** His answer was somewhat ambiguous.

## 4. Denuded (Adj.)

**Trick:** Accent

**Meaning:** to remove of its covering, possessions or assets

**Synonyms:** Bare, Clear, Expose, Strip

**Antonyms:**

**Sentence:** The storm completely denuded the trees.

## 5. Substantive (adj.)

**Trick:** Sabse Important Tent

**Meaning :** Having a firm basis in reality and so important, meaningful (मूल)

**Synonyms:** Considerable, Biggish, Major, Significant

**Antonyms:** Minute, Trivial, Marginal

**Sentence:** Substantive research on the subject needs to be carried out.



## 6. Potent (Adj.)

**Trick: Potential**

**Meaning** : Having Great Power or influence

**Synonyms**: Efficient, Strong, Significant

**Antonyms** : Feeble, Infirm, Anonymous

**Sentence**: The medicint had a potent effect on disease.

## 7. Deprive (verb)

**Trick : De + Privacy**

**Meaning: Prevent from having or using something**

**Synonyms: Denude, Abate, Strip, Depose**

**Antonyms: Initiate, Invest, Appoint, Elect**

**Sentence: Never deprive someone of hope.**

## 8. Unleash (verb)

**Trick:** Release

**Meaning:** Cause to be released or become unrestrained

**Synonyms:** Loose

**Antonyms:** Restraint

**Sentence:** The result will now unleash furious demands for the resignation



## 9. Cite (Noun)

**Trick:** Site / Recite

**Meaning:** Refer to as an evidence

**Synonyms :** Adduce, Mention, Quote

**Antonyms :** Disregard, Ignore, Neglect, Overlook

**Sentence:** Please cite my gratitude to him.

## 10. Purposive (Adj.)

**Trick :** Purpose

**Meaning :** Having or done with purpose

**Synonyms:** Deliberate, Planned, Voluntary

**Antonyms:** Inadvertent, Unwitting, Accidental

**Sentence:** His life has a sense of purposive onward movement.
