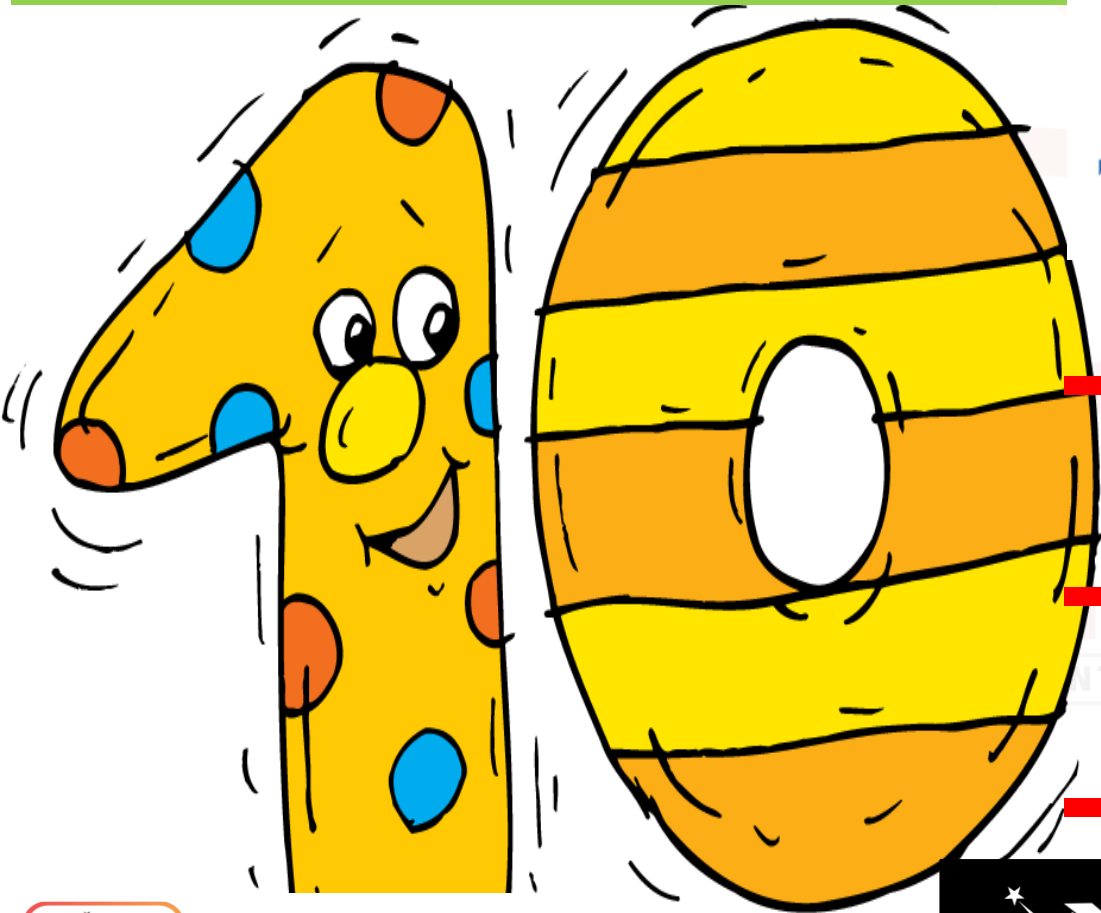

# 1. Pandora's Box

**Meaning:** A process that once begun generate many complicated problems

**Sentence:** The report could open up a Pandora's box of claims from similar cases.



## 2. Lethal (adj.)

**Trick:** Leath = Death

**Meaning:** Sufficient to cause death  
(जानलेवा)

**Synonyms:** Fatal, Deadly, Mortal

**Antonyms:** Beneficial, Salubrious

**Sentence:** This poison is absolutely lethal.



### 3. Scant (verb)

**Trick:** Pant

**Meaning:** Barely sufficient or adequate  
(अल्प)

**Synonyms:** Little, Minimal

**Antonyms:** Adequate, Enough

**Sentence:** He paid scant attention to what was said.



## 4. Clamour (Noun)

**Trick:** Glamour mai Clamour

**Meaning:** A loud & confused noise (कोलाहल)

**Synonyms:** Hue & cry, outcry, Tumult

**Antonyms:** Murmur, Rumble, Mumble

**Sentence:** There was a clamour of voices outside the house.



## 5. Espouse (verb)

**Trick:** Very Edge

**Meaning :** Adopt or support (सहायता देना)

**Synonyms:** Embrace, Commit, Engage

**Antonyms:** Separate, Divorce

**Sentence:** Followers of the sect espouse pure love.



## 6. Exonerate (verb)

**Trick:** Ex + Honour

**Meaning:** Absolve from blame or guilty  
(हक़ बहाल करना)

**Synonyms:** Clear, Acquit, Release, Discharge

**Antonyms:** Guilty, Blameable, Accused

**Sentence:** All are exonerated in Babri Masjid case.





## 7. Reprimand (noun)

**Trick:** Remand

**Meaning:** A formal expression of disapproval (डांटना)

**Synonyms:** Rebuke, Reproof, Admonish

**Antonyms:** Acclamation, Honour

**Sentence:** His boss gave him a reprimand for being late.



## 8. Stockpiling (Noun)

**Trick:** Stock Pile

**Meaning:** Accumulated a large stock of  
(भंडार)



**Synonyms:** Store, Supply, Amass

**Antonyms:** Discard, Ditch

**Sentence:** They have a stockpile of weapons.

## 9. Reluctant

**Meaning:** Unwilling to do something contrary to your custom (अनिच्छुक)

**Synonyms:** Uneager, Averse, Unwilling

**Antonyms:** Eager, Glad, Enthusiastic

**Sentence:** Sita was reluctant to go with him.

## 10. Maraud (verb)

**Trick:** Mar aur

**Meaning:** A sudden short attack  
लूटना, लूट-पाट करना

**Synonyms:** Foray, Raid

**Antonyms :** Protect, Behave

**Sentence:** The Marauding Mob overran the houses in different areas.
