- President Droupadi Murmu has approved 103 Gallantry awards to Armed Forces and Central Armed Police Forces personnel on Independence Day.
- These are four Kirti Chakras including three posthumous, 18 Shaurya Chakras including four posthumous and one Bar to Sena Medal (Gallantry).
- Among the Gallantry awards are 63 Sena Medals (Gallantry) including two posthumous, 11 Nao Sena Medals (Gallantry) and six Vayu Sena Medals (Gallantry).
- The President has also approved 39 Mention-in-Despatches, including posthumously to Army Dog Kent, for their significant contributions to different military operations.

### President Murmu presents National Geoscience awards 2023

- The President of India, Droupadi Murmu conferred the prestigious National Geoscience Awards (NGA) for the year 2023 at a grand ceremony held at the Rashtrapati Bhavan Cultural Centre New Delhi.

- **The National Geoscience Awards** continue to symbolize recognition and appreciation for outstanding achievements in geosciences, mineral exploration, and natural hazard investigations driving forward the pursuit of excellence and sustainable development.

### NIRF Ranking 2024: IIT Madras tops in overall category

- Union Minister for Education Dharmendra Pradhan has released the India Rankings 2024, which implements the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) drafted for this purpose by the Ministry of Education in 2015.
- This is the 9th consecutive edition of India Rankings of HEIs in India. Four distinct additions to 2024 edition of India Rankings are as follows:
- i) Introduction of three new categories namely State Public Universities, Open Universities, and Skill Universities; and
- ii) Integration of "Innovation" ranking into the India Rankings using NIRF framework.
- Indian Institute of Technology Madras retains its 1st position in Overall Category for the sixth consecutive year, i.e. 2019 to 2024 and in Engineering for 9th consecutive year, i.e. from 2016 to 2024.
- Top 100 in Overall category consists of 23 state public universities, 22 private deemed universities, 16 IITs, 9 NITs, 7 each central universities 7 private universities, 4 each AIIMS, IISERs and Govt. deemed universities, 3 Other CFTIs and 1 college.
- Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru tops the Universities Category for ninth consecutive year. It stood first in Research Institutions Category for the fourth consecutive year.
- IIM Ahmedabad tops in Management subject retaining its first position for fifth consecutive year.

## Chapter 11: GDP Forecasting

### Ind-Ra ups FY25 GDP growth forecast to 7.5% on expectation of high demand

- India Ratings & Research (Ind-Ra) upped India's GDP growth forecast for the current fiscal to 7.5 percent from 7.1 percent projected earlier on an expectation of improved consumption demand.
- The ongoing growth momentum led by government capex, deleveraged balance sheets of corporates/banks, and incipient private corporate capex cycle has now found support from Union Budget.

### Deloitte India predicts economic growth between 7% and 7.2% in FY25

- Deloitte's India Economic Outlook for August 2024 predicts strong economic growth between 7.0% and 7.2% in FY25, driven by robust economic fundamentals, surpassing the Economic Survey's prediction, but aligning with the Reserve Bank of India's outlook.
- According to the outlook, despite modest private consumption due to various factors, there is a noticeable shift towards non-food and discretionary spending. Rural spending preferences offer significant growth opportunities for businesses.

### SBI projects GDP growth of 7 pc in FY25

- The State Bank of India in a report project that India's real GDP will grow by 7.0 per cent year-on-year in FY25, which is slightly lower than the RBI's forecast of 7.2 per cent.
- The report noted that the slight downgrade by 20 basis points is based on the global headwinds that are beginning to materialize.
- The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) of the Reserve Bank of India maintained its overall growth projection at 7.2 per cent for FY25.

### Goldman Sachs Group cuts India's 2024 and 2025 GDP growth forecasts

- Goldman Sachs Group Inc. has lowered India's growth forecast by 20 basis points each for this year and the next, citing a contraction in central government expenditure.
- The bank now expects the nation's economy to expand at 6.7% in calendar 2024, and 6.4% in 2025.

### Moody's Ratings raises India's GDP growth forecast to 7.2 percent for 2024

- Moody's Ratings has raised its real GDP growth projections for India, forecasting a robust 7.2 percent growth for the fiscal year 2024, up from a previous estimate of 6.8 percent.
- The New York-based global rating agency has also raised its growth projections to 6.6 percent for 2025, up from 6.4 percent.
- Moody's noted that the Indian economy grew 7.8 percent year-over-year in the first quarter of 2024, despite tight monetary policy and efforts toward fiscal consolidation.

### Indian Army launches E-SeHAT Tele-Consultancy for Veterans

- The Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) has launched the Electronic Services e-Health Assistance and Tele-consultation (E-SeHAT) module.
- The E-SeHAT Tele-consultancy would enable ECHS beneficiaries in obtaining online Tele-consultation for medical treatment from their homes without visiting the ECHS Polyclinic.

### Rapido becomes unicorn with fresh \$120 million funding

- Ride-hailing startup Rapido has raised a funding of \$120 million Capital in its latest Series E funding round led by its existing investor West Bridge, thus making it the latest company to join the coveted unicorn club.
- The investor poured in the fresh capital through three of its related entities – Setu AIF Trust, Konark Trust, and MMPL Trust, as per regulatory filings.
- The firm's operating revenue surged 3X to ₹443 crore during FY23. The steep growth in scale also caused a 54 per cent spike in losses which stood at ₹675 crore in FY23.

### State Conclave on Yuga Yugeen Bharat Museum inaugurated in New Delhi

- Union Minister of Culture and Tourism, Gajendra Singh Shekhawat has inaugurated a three-day 'State Museum Conclave on the upcoming Yuga Yugeen Bharat Museum', organized by the Ministry of Culture at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi.
- This three-day gathering aims to foster collaboration among State Museums and the Central Government in realizing the Prime Minister, Narendra Modi's vision for the 'Yuga Yugeen Bharat Museum' that aims to exemplify global best practices.

- The chips, which will be packaged at the Jagiroad facility in Assam, will power electric vehicles, healthcare devices, mobile phones, laptops, and other key products of leading global companies around the world.

#### Textile Ministry kick starts 'VIRAASAT' exhibition to celebrate 10th National Handloom Day

- The Textile Ministry is organising a fortnight-long exhibition called "VIRAASAT," to celebrate the 10th National Handloom Day, which commenced at Handloom Haat in Janpath.
- The National Handloom Development Corporation Ltd (NHDC), an arm of the Textiles Ministry is organising this handloom expo.

#### Government releases commemorative stamps for the 33rd Paris Olympics

- Minister of Communications, Jyotiraditya Scindia and Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports, Dr Mansukh Mandaviya have released a set of four commemorative postage stamps to celebrate the 33rd Olympics Games currently going on in Paris.
- These stamps represent sports such as Javelin Throw, Field Hockey, Sailing and Table Tennis.

#### Bharat Forge arm gets license to make defence products

- Bharat Forge, wholly-owned subsidiary of Kalyani Strategic Systems (KSSL), has been granted defence license for manufacture of various defence products specially designed for military application at its Jejuri unit.
- The license has been granted by the Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade under The Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951.

#### Purandar Highlands exports India's first GI-tagged fig juice to Poland

- Purandar Highlands Farmers Producer Company Ltd has achieved a significant milestone by exporting India's first GI-tagged fig juice to Poland.
- This follows the successful export of India's first commercial consignment of GI-tagged Purandar figs to Hong Kong in February 2023.

#### Government declares Adichunchanagiri in Karnataka and Choolannur in Kerala as Peacock Sanctuary

- Union Minister for Environment, Forest, and Climate Change, Mr. Bhupender Yadav, announced the creation of two new Peacock Sanctuaries in India: Adichunchanagiri in Karnataka and Choolannur in Kerala.
- This decision shows the government's ongoing effort to protect wildlife and the national bird, the peacock.

#### National Commission for Women Inaugurates Digital Shakti Center in New Delhi

- The National Commission for Women has inaugurated the Digital Shakti Center to combat cyber crimes against women in New Delhi.
- The centre is a dedicated facility that aims at raising awareness about cyber crimes. It will provide essential technical support for registering and addressing complaints.

#### Telangana Govt, World Bank to prepare roadmap for an impactful outcome for people of State



- The Telangana State government and the World Bank have decided to develop a roadmap enabling partnership between the State government and the World Bank for making a positive, ambitious and highly impactful outcome relating to lives of around four crore people of the State.
- The focus of the partnership will be on initiatives for skill development, urban rejuvenation and re-imagination, net zero developments, healthcare, diagnostics and electronic records among others.

### Third edition of 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign set for August 9-15

- The third edition of the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign, aimed at fostering patriotism and national pride by encouraging citizens to display the national flag at their homes, will run from August 9 to August 15.

### Odisha launches India's first 'Rice ATM'

- The Odisha government has introduced India's first round-the-clock grain ATM, also known as the 'rice ATM,' to revolutionise the Public Distribution System (PDS) for ration cardholders.
- The Annapurthi Grain ATM, as it is officially known, is capable of dispensing up to 50 kg grain in just five minutes, with an error rate of only 0.01%.

### Government approves 8 New Railway Line Projects

- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved eight projects of the ministry of railways with a total estimated cost of around Rs.24,657 crore.
- The projects will cover 14 districts in seven states, including Odisha, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Telangana, and West Bengal.
- The eight major new railway line route projects approved by the union cabinet include Gunupur-Therubali (New Line), Junagarh-Nabrangpur, Badampahar-Kandujhargarh, Bangriposi-Gorumahisani, Malkangiri-Pandurangapuram (via Bhadrachalam), Buramara-Chakulia, Jalna-Jalgaon, and Bikramshila-Katareah.

### India's defence exports soar by 78 percent in first quarter of 2024-25

- India's defence exports soared by 78 percent in the first quarter of 2024-25 as compared to the same period last fiscal year.
- According to the Defence Ministry, defence exports increased to rupees 6,915 crores in the first quarter of 2024-25, compared to ₹3,865 crore in the same quarter of the previous year.

### Mann dedicates Punjab Help Centre for NRIs at IGI Airport

- Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann unveiled a pioneering initiative for the Punjabi diaspora with the inauguration of the 'Punjab Help Centre' at Terminal 3 of Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.
- 'Punjab Help Centre will operate 24X7, offering a range of services to assist NRIs and other passengers.

### PMJDY reaches 53 crore beneficiaries and ₹2.28 lakh crore in deposits

- The flagship financial inclusion scheme of the Centre, Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), which will be completing a decade on August 15, has 52.99 crore total

beneficiaries (account-holders) across the States with total balance in PMJDY accounts at ₹2,28,362 crore, as on 31 July 2024.

- It has largely been women-centric with **29.48 crore** women beneficiaries while **35.27 crore** of total accounts are from rural and semi-urban branches, as per the latest data. Nearly **36 crore RuPay Debit cards** have been issued.

#### Madhya Pradesh govt gives cash to girl students to buy sanitary napkins

- Madhya Pradesh has become the first state in the country to give money to girl students to buy sanitary napkins.
- In some states like Karnataka, Rajasthan and Delhi, free sanitary napkins are given to students but cash is being given only in Madhya Pradesh.

#### Bihar government mandates Registration of Temples, Mutts, And Trusts

- The Bihar government mandated registration of temples, mutts and trusts, and directed all District Magistrates in the State to ensure that the bodies are registered and details of their immovable assets are submitted to the Bihar State Board of Religious Trusts (BSBRT) soon.
- The BSBRT operates under the State's Law Department and its records say there are about 2,512 unregistered temples and mutts across the State owning 4,321.64 acres of land.

#### GoI declared August 23rd as National Space Day

- The Government of India has declared August 23rd as "National Space Day" to celebrate the remarkable success of the Chandrayaan-3 Mission, which accomplished safe and soft landing of the Vikram Lander and deployed the Pragyaan rover on the lunar surface near the South Pole.
- This historic achievement places India among an elite group of space faring nations, making India the fourth country to land on the Moon and the first to do so near the south pole of the Moon.

#### BHEL gets 1,600 MW thermal power project from Damodar Valley Corporation

- State-owned BHEL has secured a 1,600 MW project from Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC).
- The coal-based unit will be set up in the Koderma district of Jharkhand on an EPC (Engineering, Procurement, and Construction) basis.
- The 2x800 MW Koderma Supercritical Thermal Power Project (STPP) has been awarded through International Competitive Bidding (ICB).

#### Neelakurinji becomes a 'threatened species' officially

- Neelakurinji (*Strobilanthes kunthiana*), the purplish flowering shrub, that blooms once in 12 years, has been included on the IUCN (International Union for Conservation of Nature) official Red List of Threatened Species.
- The latest global assessment confirms its threatened status in the Vulnerable (Criteria A2c) category of the IUCN. The mass blooming of the flower is a huge tourist attraction.

#### Chhattisgarh govt. to develop fourth tiger reserve in State

- Chhattisgarh government decided to declare a new tiger reserve covering areas of Guru Ghasidas National Park and Tamor Pingla wildlife sanctuary in the state.

- This will be the fourth tiger reserve in the state.
- Currently, the state has three tiger reserves - Indravati (in Bijapur district), Udanti-Sitanadi (Gariaband) and Achanakmar (Mungeli).

### Three more Ramsar wetland sites now in India, taking total to 85

- Three more Indian sites have been added to the list of wetlands of international importance under the Ramsar Convention, taking the total number of such highly-recognized waterlogged ecosystems in the country to 85.
- The Nanjarayan Bird Sanctuary and the Kazhuveli Bird Sanctuary in Tamil Nadu, and the Tawa Reservoir in Madhya Pradesh are the three wetlands which have got the Ramsar site tag.
- The 85 Indian wetlands on the Ramsar list span over 1.35 million hectares. Tamil Nadu has the maximum number of Ramsar sites (18) followed by Uttar Pradesh (10).
- This takes our tally to 85 Ramsar sites, covering an area of 13,58,068 ha in India.

### Odisha to bring five Royal Bengal tigers from Maharashtra, MP by September

- To bolster big cat population in Odisha, forest officials have begun the process of relocating five Royal Bengal Tigers from Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh, with the transfer scheduled to be completed in September.
- According to Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (PCCF)-Wildlife, Susanta Nanda, three of these tigers will be released into the Debrigarh Wildlife Sanctuary in Sambalpur, while the remaining two will be introduced into the Similipal Tiger Reserve in Mayurbhanj.

### Delhi Airport 1st In Country To Get 'Net Zero Carbon Emission' Status

- Delhi's IGI Airport has become the first Indian airport to achieve the status of 'Net Zero Carbon Emission Airport' (Level 5 certification) under the Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) programme of Airport Council International (ACI).
- Initially the airport had set a target of achieving a net zero carbon emission by 2030. But through various measures including use of renewable energy, promotion of electric vehicles and development of infrastructure for a green airport, DIAL achieved its target ahead of schedule.

### New AI platform will connect farmers and scientists over phone, aid in pest control

- The Union Government has launched the AI-based National Pest Surveillance System (NPSS) that will help farmers to connect with agriculture scientists and experts on controlling pests using their phones.
- NPSS aims to reduce the dependence of farmers on pesticide retailers, and inculcate a scientific approach among them towards pest management.

### India shines at the 17th International Earth Sciences Olympiad

- The Indian student team has bagged multiple prestigious medals at the 17th edition of the International Earth Sciences Olympiad (IESO) held in Beijing, China.
- The four-member Indian team, comprising students from Gujarat, Kerala, Chhattisgarh, and Rajasthan, achieved remarkable success by winning three gold medals, three bronze medals, and two silver medals across three competition categories: Theory and Practical, Earth System Project, and International Team Field Investigation.

### Rajnath Singh inaugurates new maritime rescue coordination centre in Chennai

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has inaugurated a new Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC) of the Coast Guard in Chennai.
- At the event, he also inaugurated two new Coast Guard units – the Regional Marine Pollution Response Centre (RMPRC) in Chennai and a Coast Guard Air Enclave in Puducherry – through video-conferencing.

### India approves additional 251 MW Power Exports from Nepal

- India's Designated Authority for Cross-Border Trade has approved an additional 251 MW of power exports from 12 hydropower projects in Nepal.
- For the first time, Nepal would be exporting power to Bihar through a medium-term power sales agreement. This takes the total allowed quantum from 690 MW from 16 projects to 941 MW from 28 projects.

### Ola becomes only EV maker to secure PLI certification for four electric scooters

- Ola Electric's S1 X 3 kWh and S1 X 4 kWh scooters have received certification for compliance with the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for the automobile and auto components sector.
- This certification, awarded by the Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI), comes after Ola Electric successfully met the minimum localisation criteria of 50% as mandated by the Ministry of Heavy Industries.
- The company stands to receive incentives ranging from 13% to 18% of the determined sales value of compliant products for up to five consecutive financial years starting from Fiscal 2024.

### Ministry of Education launches second cycle of Capacity Building Program on Specific Learning Disability

- The Ministry of Education has launched the second cycle of its Capacity Building Program on Specific Learning Disability (SLD) under the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP).
- Building on the success of the first cycle, this programme is designed to empower Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) with the skills and knowledge necessary, to support students with specific learning disabilities.
- The first round of the 'Capacity Building Program on Specific Learning Disabilities' was conducted from January to July 2024 partnered with Changeinkk Foundation. In the first round, a cohort of 27 HEIs participated in the programme including Central Universities, IITs, IIITs, IIMs, IISERs, SPAs, and NITs.

### Actor Vijay launches his political party Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam's flag

- Tamil cinema's leading actor and Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam president Vijay launched his party's flag and flag song at the party headquarters at Panaiyur in Chennai.
- Vijay introduced the two-coloured flag with red on top and bottom; yellow in the middle; and a flower resembling Vaagai surrounded by 28 stars at the centre with two trumpeting tuskers facing each other on either side.

- Mr. Vijay had in February, this year announced the formation of his political party Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam and declared that his party would enter the electoral fray in the 2026 Tamil Nadu Assembly elections.

#### Union FM Nirmala Sitharaman inaugurates GST Bhawan at Udaipur

- Union Minister for Finance and Corporate Affairs Nirmala Sitharaman inaugurated the GST Bhawan, an Official complex of CGST, Udaipur Commissionerate under the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), at Udaipur, Rajasthan.
- The Union Finance Minister also launched ICETAB 2.0, a handheld device for customs operations, and expressed hope that it will help in uploading real-time examination reports and in quicker clearance of cargoes.

#### Eastern Railway develops 'Prabodh' chatbox for easier access to railway rules

- The 161-year-old Kanchrapara Workshop of Eastern Railway (ER) in West Bengal -- one of the oldest such establishments in the country -- has come up with an Artificial Intelligence-based chatbox named 'Prabodh' to help ER employees remain abreast with the latest rules and regulations.
- Prabodh is being touted as a human resource management wizard that will help employees give their best while keeping them informed about their responsibilities and rights.

#### DGCA fines Air India Rs 90 lakh for operating flight with unqualified crew

- Civil aviation regulator Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has slapped a fine of ₹90 lakh on Air India for operating a flight on July 9 from Mumbai to Riyadh with an unqualified crew.
- Besides, the watchdog has slapped fines of Rs 6 lakh and Rs 3 lakh on Air India's Director of Operations and Director of Training, respectively, for the lapse.

#### PM Modi presents BHISHM Cubes to Ukraine during first visit to Kyiv

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has presented four BHISHM (Bharat Health Initiative for Sahyog Hita and Maitri) Cubes to the Ukrainian government during his visit to the war-torn country where he met President Volodymyr Zelenskyy under the shadow of the raging war with Russia.
- Each BHISHM Cube consists of medicines and equipment for the first line of care for all kinds of injuries and medical situations. It also includes surgical equipment for a basic operation room that can manage 10-15 basic surgeries per day.

#### NCERT and Education Ministry launches e-magazine 'Sapno ki Udaan'

- The Union Ministry of Education released the inaugural edition of the e-magazine 'Sapno ki Udaan'.
- The e-magazine was launched on the occasion of the first National Space Day, which was observed across the country on 23 August to commemorate the soft landing of the Vikram lander of the Chandrayaan -3 mission on the south pole of the Moon on 23 August 2023.
- The theme of the inaugural Sapno ki Udaan e-magazine was 'Space'.

#### Samantham Tank in Madurai to be converted into bird sanctuary



- Following Madurai Nature Cultural Foundation recommendations, the Tamil Nadu Forest Department will convert the Samanatham Tank in the Madurai district will be converted into a bird sanctuary.
- There are 17 bird sanctuaries in Tamil Nadu, 15 wildlife sanctuaries, and four Tiger reserves.

#### Centre to create 5 new districts in Ladakh

- The Ministry of Home Affairs has decided to create five new districts in the union territory of Ladakh.
- The creation of new districts will take the benefits meant for the people to their doorsteps by bolstering governance in every nook and cranny.
- These districts are – Zaskar, Drass, Sham, Nubra and Changthang.
- Ladakh currently has only two districts – Leh and Kargil.

#### Cabinet approves BioE3 (Biotechnology for Economy, Environment and Employment) Policy

- The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved the proposal 'BioE3 (Biotechnology for Economy, Environment and Employment) Policy for Fostering High Performance Biomanufacturing' of the Department of Biotechnology.
- The salient features of BioE3 policy include innovation-driven support to R&D and entrepreneurship across thematic sectors.
- This will accelerate technology development and commercialization by establishing Biomanufacturing & Bio-AI hubs and Biofoundry. Along with prioritizing regenerative bioeconomy models of green growth, this policy will facilitate the expansion of India's skilled workforce and provide a surge in job creation.

#### C-DAC Inaugurates Model EV Charging Station and Hardware Emulation Facility

- The Secretary, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), S. Krishnan has inaugurated the Model Indigenous Electric Vehicle Charging Station at C-DAC Thiruvananthapuram, Technopark Campus.
- This center will have various AC and DC fast chargers for vehicles ranging from 2W to Heavy vehicles and, Play a crucial role in catalyzing an ecosystem for the promotion of the charging infrastructure with indigenous EV chargers research, development, commercialization, and manufacturing through industries.

#### Amazon launches AI assistant chatbot 'Rufus' in India

- Ecommerce major Amazon India has launched its artificial intelligence (AI)-powered shopping assistant 'Rufus' in India.
- Rufus is currently available in beta mode in India, and available only to some customers.

#### Government approves 4 Start-Ups in the field of Technical Textiles

- Secretary, Ministry of Textiles chaired the 8th Empowered Programme Committee (EPC) meeting under the National Technical Textiles Mission, at Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi.
- The committee has approved 4 Start-Ups with a grant of approx. INR 50 Lakhs, each, under the 'Grant for Research & Entrepreneurship across Aspiring Innovators in Technical Textiles (GREAT)' scheme.



- The committee has also approved a grant of approx. INR 20 Cr. to 5 Education Institutes to introduce courses in Technical Textiles under the 'General Guidelines for Enabling of Academic Institutes in Technical Textiles'.

### PMJDY completes a decade of successful implementation

- The world's largest financial inclusion programme, Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) completed 10 years on 28 August 2024.
- The Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) was launched by the government of India on 28 August 2014 with the aim of bringing the unbanked population within the formal banking system.
- The scheme launched in 2014, has proven to be the foundation stone in bringing over 80 percent of Indian women under the ambit of financial inclusion.
- A significant boost in the bank account ownership of women in a decade, it has gone up from just 26 percent in 2011 to 78 percent in 2021.
- Out of the total 53.13 crore Jan Dhan accounts over 30 crore are women's accounts. Over 35 crore of the Jan Dhan account hail from rural or semi-urban areas.

### Rajasthan & MP govts to develop 'Shri Krishna Gaman Path' connecting Mathura to Ujjain

- Rajasthan Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma announced a new religious circuit called 'Shri Krishna Gaman Path' which will connect Krishna's birthplace Mathura with Ujjain in Madhya Pradesh.
- This new circuit will be built connecting the places where Krishna left his footprints while travelling to Ujjain from his birthplace in Mathura.

### Maharashtra becomes first state to adopt Unified Pension Scheme

- The Maharashtra Cabinet has approved the central government's Unified Pension Scheme (UPS), becoming the first state to do so.
- The cabinet also cleared the proposal to expand the uninterrupted power supply scheme to more farmers in the state. They would get supply during the day. It cleared the ₹7,000 crore Nar-Par-Girna River linking scheme that would primarily benefit north Maharashtra districts like Nashik and Jalgaon.

### Union Cabinet approved 'Agriculture Infrastructure Fund' for progressive expansion

- The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister, Narendra Modi approved the progressive expansion in the Central Sector Scheme of financing facility under 'Agriculture Infrastructure Fund' to make it more attractive, impactful, and inclusive.
- **Viable Farming Assets-** To allow all eligible beneficiaries of scheme to create of infrastructure covered under 'viable projects for building community farming assets'.
- **Integrated Processing projects-** To include integrated primary secondary processing projects in eligible activities under AIF. However standalone secondary projects would not be eligible under MoFPI schemes.
- **PM KUSUM Component-A-** To allow convergence of Component-A of PM-KUSUM with AIF for farmers/groups of farmers/ Farmer Producer Organizations/ Cooperatives/ Panchayats.
- **NABSanrakshan-** In addition to CGTMSE, it is proposed to extend AIF credit guarantee coverage of FPOs through the NABSanrakshan Trustee Company Pvt. Ltd. also.

### Union Cabinet approves rolling out Private FM Radio to 234 uncovered new cities & towns

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led Union Cabinet has approved a proposal for e-auctions to set up 730 channels in 234 new cities across the country with an estimated reserve price of ₹784.87 crore, as part of the initiative to expand the reach of private FM Radio channels.
- The Cabinet decision on the rollout of private FM Radio to 234 cities and towns will enhance access to diverse and local content, thus encouraging creativity and encouraging local languages as well as cultures.
- Many of these cities and towns are located in aspirational districts and areas affected by Left-Wing Extremism. A maximum of 100 channels are to be provided in 32 cities/towns of Uttar Pradesh, followed by 68 across 22 cities/towns of Andhra Pradesh, 61 in 20 cities/towns of Madhya Pradesh, and 59 in 19 cities/towns of Rajasthan.

### Sports Minister launches 'Retired Sportsperson Empowerment Training' (RESET) Programme

- Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya has launched the "Retired Sportsperson Empowerment Training" (RESET) Programme on the occasion of National Sports Day in New Delhi.
- RESET Programme is aimed at empowering retired sportspersons who have played for the country and brought immense laurels to the nation.
- The programme will support retired athletes on their career development journey by empowering them with the necessary knowledge and skills and making them more employable.

## Chapter 13: Current Affairs (International)

### India elected as Vice-Chair of the Supply Chain Council of IPEF

- India has been elected as the Vice-Chair of one of the three supply chain bodies set up under the Indo-Pacific Economic Framework for Prosperity (IPEF) Agreement relating to Supply Chain Resilience.
- India and 13 other IPEF partners have established three bodies under the IPEF's agreement on supply chain resilience. The pact came into force in February 2024.

### Sri Lanka announces visa-free access to Indians, nationals from 34 other countries from Oct 31

- The Sri Lankan government has announced visa-free access to citizens from 35 countries, including India, the U.K. and the U.S. to the island nation for six months.
- Countries on the list include India, the U.K., China, the U.S., Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, Spain, Australia, Denmark, Poland, Kazakhstan, Saudi Arabia, the UAE, Nepal, Indonesia, Russia, and Thailand.
- Other countries include Malaysia, Japan, France, Canada, the Czech Republic, Italy, Switzerland, Austria, Israel, Belarus, Iran, Sweden, South Korea, Qatar, Oman, Bahrain and New Zealand.
- Visitors from India, China, Russia, Japan, Malaysia, Thailand, and Indonesia received tourist visas free of charge to Sri Lanka.

### North Korean Leader Kim Jong Un Unveils New 'Suicide Drones'

- North Korean leader Kim Jong Un recently unveiled a new type of "suicide drone".
- These drones, designed to carry explosives and crash into enemy targets like guided missiles.
- The test was successful, with all drones accurately identifying and destroying their designated targets after flying along preset routes.

### Pakistani Christian becomes first in Goa to get citizenship under CAA

- Joseph Francis A. Pereira, a Christian from Pakistan, has become the first person in Goa to receive Indian citizenship under the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA).
- Chief Minister Pramod Sawant presented Pereira with his citizenship certificate during a ceremony in Panaji, the state capital.
- The Citizenship Amendment Act allows Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, Christians, Parsis, and Buddhists from neighboring countries—Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Afghanistan—who entered India before December 31, 2014, to apply for citizenship after verification.

### Siemens Healthineers gets India nod for Mpox test kit

- German healthcare firm Siemens Healthineers AG received the Indian drug regulator's approval to manufacture mpox detection kits in the country, a significant step to help screen and prevent the spread of the viral infection.
- The kits will be manufactured by the company's molecular diagnostics manufacturing unit in Vadodara, which has a production capacity of one million tests per annum.

## Chapter 14: Banking & Financial

### 11 PSU banks charge Rs 2,331 crore from account holders for not maintaining minimum balance in FY24

- 11 public sector banks—excluding State Bank of India (SBI) — have charged Rs 2,331 crore from account holders for their failure to maintain minimum balance in savings banks in FY2024, a rise of 25.63 per cent from Rs 1,855.43 crore in FY2023.
- These banks collected Rs 5,614 crore from account holders for not maintaining the minimum balance in the last three years, according to Ministry of Finance figures.
- SBI stopped charging penalty for not maintaining minimum balance since FY2020.
- Punjab National Bank (PNB) collected the maximum amount of Rs 633.4 crore from their customers, followed by Bank of Baroda Rs 386.51 crore and Indian Bank Rs 369.16 crore.

### July GST mop-up at 3-month high, rises 10.3% to ₹1.82 lakh crore

- Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections in July saw a significant increase, totaling Rs 182,075 crore, which marks a 10.3% rise compared to Rs 165,105 crore collected in July 2023.
- This growth was observed across all categories: Central GST (CGST), State GST (SGST), Integrated GST (IGST), and cess.
- Year-to-date figures for 2024 show a 10.2% increase in GST collections, amounting to Rs 7.38 lakh crore, compared to Rs 6.70 lakh crore in the same period of 2023.

### RBL Bank becomes first private sector lender to merge UPI and NCMC in RuPay credit cards

- RBL Bank has introduced a new RuPay Credit Card, integrating both Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and National Common Mobility Card (NCMC) features.
- This innovation makes RBL Bank the first private sector bank in India to offer these combined payment capabilities in a single card.
- The integration allows cardholders to make payments via UPI and get hassle-free travel with the NCMC feature.

### IRDAI imposes penalty of Rs 2 Cr on HDFC Life for violating regulations

- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has imposed a penalty totaling Rs 2 crore on HDFC Life for violating various IRDAI regulations.
- The penalty of Rs 1 crore was levied for issues related to the protection of policyholders' interests. Additionally, a penalty of Rs 1 crore was imposed for irregularities concerning the outsourcing of services by the company.

### Google Pay, PhonePe, Amazon Pay, Cred, MobiKwik seek entry into RBI's eRupee pilot program

- Five prominent payment companies, including Google Pay, Walmart-backed PhonePe, and Amazon Pay, have applied to join the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) pilot program for the eRupee, India's central bank digital currency (CBDC).
- Fintech firms Cred and Mobikwik have also submitted applications.
- The RBI launched the eRupee pilot in December 2022, but transaction volumes have declined significantly since an initial surge, reflecting the challenges central banks worldwide face in popularizing digital currencies.

### LIC launches 4 new term life insurance plans

- Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has launched new term life insurance plans for providing term insurance and safety net against loan repayments – LIC's Yuva Term, LIC's Digi Term, LIC's Yuva Credit Life, LIC's Digi Credit Life. The plans are available online and offline.

### DBS Bank India launches exclusive banking program for senior citizens

- DBS Bank India has launched "DBS Golden Circle," a priority banking program for senior citizens.
- The program, designed for resident Indian citizens aged 60 and above, offers exclusive benefits and services, including attractive interest rates on savings accounts and fixed deposits, enhanced security features, and personalised financial services to address income insecurity, which is a significant concern for the elderly, as highlighted in the India Ageing Report 2023 by the United Nations Population Fund.

### SBI approves Rs 25,000 crore fundraising plan via issue of Tier 1 and Tier 2 bonds

- The board of India's largest public sector lender State Bank of India approved a proposal for raising funds of up to Rs 25,000 crore via the issue of Tier 1 and Tier 2 bonds.
- The bonds will be Basel-III compliant and SBI plans to raise the amount in INR/USD.
- The fundraising plan was announced by SBI along with its April-June quarter earnings where the lender reported a standalone net profit of Rs 17,035 crore, up by 0.9% over

Rs 16,884.29 crore reported in the year-ago period. It was higher than the Street's estimates of Rs 16,786 crore.

### IFC, ADB, DEG consortium to invest \$275 mn in Fourth Partner Energy

- Global investors International Finance Corporation (IFC), the Asian Development Bank (ADB), and Deutsche Investitions (DEG) have invested \$275 million in Hyderabad-based renewable energy solutions platform Fourth Partner Energy Ltd (FPEL).
- The consortium's investment will infuse capital to fund FPEL's business expansion plans which include a target portfolio of 3.5 GW of renewable energy assets by 2026.

### RBI keeps repo rate unchanged at 6.5% for 9th time in a row

- The Reserve Bank of India has decided to keep the policy repo rate unchanged at 6.50 per cent for the ninth time in a row.
- Consequently, the standing deposit facility (SDF) rate remains at 6.25 percent and the marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate at 6.75 per cent.

### Limit for tax payments via UPI to increase from ₹1 lakh to ₹5 lakh: RBI

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has proposed raising the upper limit for tax payments through the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 5 lakh per transaction.
- Currently, the transaction limit for UPI is Rs 1 lakh except for certain categories of payments which have higher transaction limits.
- It has now been decided to enhance the limit for tax payments through UPI from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 5 lakh per transaction. This will further ease tax payments by consumers through UPI.

### L& T Finance Achieves NBFC-ICC Status from RBI



- L&T Finance Ltd. has officially received its certificate of registration as a Non-Banking Financial Company (Investment and Credit Company) from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- This transition marks a shift from its previous registration as an NBFC-Core Investment Company (NBFC-CIC), following the merger with its wholly owned subsidiaries, L&T Finance, L&T Infra Credit Ltd., and L&T Mutual Fund Trustee Ltd.

#### Consumer price inflation eases to five-year low of 3.54% in July

- Retail inflation fell to the lowest in nearly five years in July, according to data released by the India Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- This was the first time in nearly five years that overall retail inflation fell below the Reserve Bank of India's 4% inflation target.
- Urban inflation declined to 2.98% in July 2024, compared to 7.20% in July 2023.
- Rural inflation declined to 4.10%, compared to 7.63% in July 2023.

#### PNB launches PNB ANTAH DRISHTI Braille Debit Card for visually impaired customers

- Punjab National Bank (PNB) has launched the PNB ANTAH DRISHTI Braille Debit Card, a new debit card specifically designed for visually impaired customers.
- The ATM limit (cash withdrawal) per day is Rs 25,000, and the PoS and eCom limits (combined) per day are Rs 60,000. Contactless transactions are accessible for individual transactions up to Rs. 5000/- without a PIN at NFC capable POS Terminals, with a daily overall limit of Rs. 5000.

#### RBI penalises CSB Bank, Union Bank of India, and Muthoot Housing Finance for non-compliance

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed monetary penalties on five financial institutions—CSB Bank, Union Bank of India, Muthoot Housing Finance, Nido Home Finance and Ashoka Viniyoga—for various regulatory non-compliances.
- Muthoot Housing Finance Company Limited was fined ₹5 lakh for governance-related violations, specifically failing to secure RBI's prior approval before changing more than 30% of its directors.

#### NPCI hives off Bhim as separate arm; Lalitha Nataraj to be CEO

- National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has hived off the UPI-based payment application Bharat Interface for Money (Bhim) as a separate subsidiary to address the growing demand for digital transactions in the country and to promote financial inclusion.
- Lalitha Nataraj, a former senior executive at IDFC First Bank, has been appointed as the chief executive officer of the new subsidiary named NPCI Bhim Services Ltd (NBSL).

#### Axis Bank launches PRIMUS super-premium credit card

- Axis Bank, one of India's largest private sector banks, has partnered with Visa to launch the 'Primus' credit card. This is a super-premium card, available by invitation only.
- This credit card targets select ultra-high net worth individuals (UHNWIs) in India.

#### WPI inflation cools to 3-month low of 2.04% in July as food prices decline



- India's wholesale price index (WPI) inflation cooled to a three-month low of 2.04 per cent in July from a 16-month high of 3.36 per cent in June, primarily on the back of a sharp reduction in food prices.
- The food price inflation stood at 3.45 per cent during the month as compared to 10.87 per cent in the preceding month.

#### **NSE Hikes Ceiling Amount Payable Out Of Investor Protection Fund Trust**

- The National Stock Exchange (NSE) has increased the maximum amount payable from its Investor Protection Fund (IPF) Trust from Rs 25 lakh to Rs 35 lakh.
- This limit will be applicable for claims received against the trading members, who have been declared defaulter or have been expelled.

#### **RBL Bank launched Vijay Fixed Deposits to honor 78th Independence Day**

- RBL Bank has launched a special "Vijay Fixed Deposits" edition to commemorate India's 78th year of independence.
- For deposits below Rs 3 crore, the "Vijay Fixed Deposits" feature a special 500-day tenor.
- The special fixed deposit plan offers competitive interest rates with 8.85% p.a. for super senior citizens, 8.60% p.a. for senior citizens, and 8.1% p.a. for regular customers, all tailored to guarantee your money grows safely.

#### **RBI imposes monetary penalties on Bank of Maharashtra**

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of ₹1,27,20,000/- on Bank of Maharashtra for non-compliance with certain directions issued by RBI on 'Loan System for Delivery of Bank Credit', 'Cyber Security Framework in Banks' and 'Know Your Customer'.
- The RBI has also imposed a monetary penalty of ₹4.90 lakh on Hinduja Leyland Finance Limited (the company) for non-compliance with certain provisions of the Reserve Bank of India (Know Your Customer (KYC)) Directions, 2016.
- This penalty has been imposed in exercise of powers conferred on RBI under the provisions of clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 58G read with clause (aa) of sub-section (5) of section 58B of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.

#### **LIC sells stake in Hindustan Copper for Rs 447 crore**

- Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has sold a 2.09 per cent stake in state-owned Hindustan Copper for Rs 447 crore through an open market transaction.
- The insurance behemoth has sold a total of 2,01,62,682 shares, or 2.085 per cent stake, in Hindustan Copper, according to a regulatory filing.
- With this, LIC's stake in the state-owned company has reduced to 6.09 per cent from 8.17 per cent.

#### **IndusInd Bank gets RBI nod to set up mutual fund asset management business**

- IndusInd Bank has received the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) nod to set up a mutual fund asset management business. It will be a wholly-owned subsidiary, the bank said in its filing to the exchanges.
- RBI has also allowed the private sector lender to infuse equity capital in the asset management subsidiary.

### Airtel Payments Bank introduces AI-powered Face Match

- Airtel Payments Bank has launched the Face Match, a new security feature designed to protect customer accounts from fraudulent activities.
- The feature uses advanced machine learning algorithms to assess potential threats and activate facial recognition verification when necessary.

### Net foreign direct investment rises to \$6.9 billion in Q1: RBI

- Net foreign direct investment (FDI) during the April-June period of the current financial year was \$6.9 billion, compared to \$4.7 billion in the year-ago period, the latest data released by the Reserve Bank of India showed.
- The increase was due to an improvement in gross inward FDI, which grew by 26.4 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) to \$22.5 billion during Q1 of 2024-25.
- Net FDI flow dropped sharply to \$9.8 billion in FY24, from \$28 billion in the previous year. In FY22, net FDI flows into the country were \$38.6 billion.

### Karnataka Bank unveils credit line on UPI in partnership with Navi Technologies

- Karnataka Bank and financial services company Navi Technologies have launched the credit line on UPI, an offering by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
- The private sector lender will be offering credit lines through a strategic partnership with Navi, marking Karnataka Bank as one of the early adopters of this next-gen credit product.

### NPCI launches 'UPI Circle' for Secure Payments Among Trusted Users

- The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has introduced a new feature called 'UPI Circle' on its Unified Payments Interface (UPI) platform.
- This feature allows primary UPI account holders to securely delegate payment responsibilities to trusted secondary users.

### Bandhan Bank launches Avni Saving Account for Women Customer

- Kolkata-based Indian Private sector bank Bandhan Bank has launched an exclusive savings account, Avni, for women customers.
- The bank launched the product on its 9th foundation day, which is on 23 August.
- The bank also launched a customer loyalty programme called Bandhan Banks Delight. The bank is women-focused, and of its 3.4 customers, 73% are women.

### RBI cancels registration of Margdarshak Financial Services over high NPAs

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cancelled the registration of Lucknow-headquartered Margdarshak Financial Services Ltd over high net NPAs and defaults on repayment to lenders.
- As on March 31, 2021, the company failed to maintain the minimum regulatory net owned fund of Rs 5 crore and minimum capital adequacy ratio of 15 per cent stipulated for NBFC-MFI.
- As per the statutory audit, as on March 31, 2021, the NBFC was facing cash flow issues and defaulted on repayment of Rs 49.27 crore to its lenders.

### Tata AIA Life launches 'Sampoorna Raksha Promise' product with ₹3 lakh instant payout feature

- Tata AIA Life Insurance has unveiled its latest term insurance product, Sampoorna Raksha Promise. This product is designed to enhance financial security.

- As per GST Rule 10A, a taxpayer is required to furnish details of a valid bank account within 30 days from the date of grant of registration, or before furnishing the details of outward supplies of goods or services or both in Form GSTR-1 or using Invoice Furnishing Facility (IFF), whichever is earlier.
- The GST Council in its meeting in July last year, had approved an amendment to Rule 10A to strengthen the registration process and to effectively deal with the menace of fake and fraudulent registrations in GST.

### Indian Navy approves Mazagon Dock to build 6 submarines with German collaboration

- Government-owned Mazagon Dock Limited (MDL) has got the Indian Navy's approval to build six submarines with the project worth Rs 60,000 crore.
- The MDL in partnership with Germany's ThyssenKrupp Marine Systems will build the submarines that are being developed under 'Project 75 India'.

- MDL and ThyssenKrupp were competing against Larsen & Toubro and Navantia. The approval came after the MDL was informed by a Commodore-rank officer of the Indian Navy (Brigadier equivalent in the Army) that they had qualified for the trial requirements.

#### **DRDO successfully tested its first Long-Range Glide Bomb GAURAV**

- The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully tested its Long-Range Glide Bomb, GAURAV, off the coast of Odisha.
- The smart bomb was dropped from the Indian Air Force's Su-30 MK-I fighter plane.
- The successful testing of the smart bomb is likely to enhance the Indian Air Force's combat capability.

#### **South Korea, US kick off annual drills over North's military, cyber threats**

- South Korea and the United States kicked off annual summertime military exercises on Monday, seeking to boost their joint readiness to fend off North Korea's weapons and cyber threats.
- The Ulchi Freedom Shield exercises, set to end on August 29, come as North Korea races to advance its nuclear and missile programmes and tries to launch reconnaissance satellites.
- The drills will reflect "realistic threats" across all domains, including the North's missile threats but also GPS jamming, cyberattacks and other lessons learned from recent incidents.

#### **Pakistan conducts successful training launch of Shaheen-II Ballistic Missile**

- The Pakistani military has conducted the successful training launch of its surface-to-surface ballistic missile Shaheen-II.
- The training launch was aimed at training of troops, validating various technical parameters and performance evaluation of different sub-systems incorporated for improved accuracy and enhanced survivability.

#### **IAF's Sarang Team Showcases India's Aviation Prowess at Egypt Airshow**

- The IAF dispatched its Sarang Helicopter Display Team to participate in the inaugural edition of the Egypt International Airshow.
- The event is scheduled to take place from September 3 to 5, 2024, at the strategically located Al-Alamein International Airport in Egypt's El Dabaa.
- The airport, situated along the Mediterranean, serves as a major hub for global air, commercial, and logistical transport, making it an apt location for an event of this magnitude.
- The Sarang team, renowned for their precision and impressive aerial displays, will be showcasing the indigenous 'Dhruv' Advanced Light Helicopters (ALH Mk-I). These helicopters, built by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL), are multi-role and multi-mission, featuring a hinge-less composite main rotor, and are designed for both military and civilian applications. The contingent will be carrying five Sarang helicopters, which are being airlifted by C-17 Globemaster aircraft for the event.

#### **India's 2nd nuclear missile submarine 'INS Arighat' commissioned by Rajnath Singh**



- India's second nuclear-powered ballistic missile submarine, the INS Arighaat, was commissioned into service at Visakhapatnam in the presence of Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.
- It joins the first such submarine, the INS Arihant, which was commissioned into service in 2016.
- The INS Arihant was quietly commissioned into service in August 2016. It has a displacement of 6,000 tonnes and is powered by an 83 MW pressurised light-water reactor with enriched uranium. INS Arighaat retains the same reactor and dimensions, but has several technological upgrades.

- Kusale scored an aggregate of 451.4 in six rounds. He had finished seventh in the qualification.

- A distinguished officer of the Indian Army, Lieutenant Colonel Kabilan Sai Ashok has made history by becoming India's youngest Olympic referee in boxing at the Paris Olympics 2024.
- This extraordinary accomplishment highlights his dedication, professionalism, and integrity, embodying the high standards of the Indian Army.

#### **Lakshya Sen claims historic win to become first Indian male shuttler to enter Olympic semis**

- Lakshya Sen made history by becoming the first male Indian shuttler to qualify for the semi-finals of an Olympics.
- He achieved this milestone by defeating Chinese Taipei's Chou Tien-chen with a score of 19-21, 21-15, 21-12 in the quarter-finals of the 2024 Paris Olympics.

#### **Manu Bhaker named flag bearer at Paris Olympics Closing Ceremony**

- India's two-time Olympic bronze medallist Manu Bhaker is set to be India's flagbearer in the closing ceremony of the Paris Olympics.
- India's men's flagbearer for the ceremony is yet to be confirmed.
- The closing ceremony of the Paris Olympics will take place on August 11.

#### **Novak Djokovic 5th player to achieve Golden Slam**

- Serbian Tennis legend Novak Djokovic became the fifth tennis player in history to claim the Golden Slam.
- Novak Djokovic won the men's singles gold medal at the 2024 Paris Olympics by defeating Spain's Carlos Alcaraz in straight sets, 7-6(3), 7-6(2), in the final.

#### **Indian Wrestler Vinesh Phogat disqualified from Paris Olympics**

- Vinesh Phogat was disqualified from the women's 50kg wrestling final at the Paris Olympics.
- The 29-year-old was found ineligible to compete on the second day as she was found 100 gram overweight during the weigh-in on the day of the final.
- Unfortunately, Vinesh Phogat will not win any medal at the Paris Olympics, if the disqualification stays.

#### **Sable becomes 1st Indian man to qualify for 3000m steeplechase final**

- Avinash Sable became the first Indian man to qualify for the 3000m steeplechase final after finishing fifth in his heat.
- But quartermiler Kiran Pahal failed to book an automatic semi-final berth in women's 400m following a seventh-place finish in her heat at the Paris Olympics.

#### **Noah Lyles wins Men's 100-Meter Gold in Paris**

- USA's Noah Lyles edged past Jamaican Kishane Thompson to win his first Olympic gold medal in a lifetime-best 9.784 seconds.
- Lyles crossed the finish line just five-thousandths of a second ahead of Thompson, who posted a time of 9.789.

#### Neeraj Chopra won Silver at Paris Olympics 2024

- Neeraj Chopra has won the Silver Medal in the men's javelin throw event with a best throw of 89.45 meters at the Paris Olympics.
- Following his performance, Chopra became the second male athlete post-independence to win two Olympic medals in an individual event.
- Grenada's Anderson Peters secured bronze with a throw of 88.54 meters.

#### India defeats Spain to clinch bronze medal at Paris Olympics

- The Indian men's hockey team led by Harmanpreet Singh won the bronze medal in the 2024 Paris Olympics, beating Spain 2-1.
- The match to decide the bronze medal was held at the Yves-du-Manoir Stadium in Paris, France. Earlier in the semi-final, India lost to Germany 3-2.
- This is the second back-to-back bronze medal for the Indian men's hockey team after their bronze medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

#### Vinesh Phogat announces retirement from wrestling

- Indian wrestler Vinesh Phogat from Haryana has announced her retirement from wrestling a day after she was disqualified from the 50kg category Paris Olympics finals.
- The seasoned wrestler was disqualified after weighing 100 grams more than the permissible limit in the morning weigh-in ahead of the final.

#### Aman Sehrawat breaks Sindhu record to be Youngest Medallist at Olympics

- Aman Sehrawat became the youngest Indian to win an Olympic medal after he won a bronze medal in the men's freestyle 57 kg wrestling event at the Paris Olympics.
- Aman Sehrawat broke the record of PV Sindhu, who won a silver medal at the 2016 Rio Olympics at the age of 21 years, 1 month, and 14 days.

#### Paris Olympics: India finishes 71st in medal tally

- USA and China both won 40 gold medals each at Paris Olympics 2024 but the United States of America topped the medals table finishing above the Asian giant only under their 44 silvers.
- India finished 71st at the Paris Olympics with one silver and five bronze.

#### India wins CAVA Women's Volleyball Nations League for the second time

- Indians beat the host Nepal 23-25, 25-14, 22-25, 25-21, 15-5 in the CAVA Women's Volleyball Nations League final.
- Nepal lost to India 3-2 in the finals at the Dashrath Stadium in Kathmandu.
- This was the second time Nepal was facing off India in the title match at home and first since the 13th South Asian Games.

#### India's Pramod Bhagat suspended from Paris Paralympics Over Breach of Anti-Doping Regulations

- India's Tokyo 2020 Paralympic gold medal winner Pramod Bhagat, Badminton, has been suspended for a period of 18 months for breaching the anti-doping regulations.

- As a result of the suspension, Pramod will miss the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games.

#### **PB-BCL sign landmark deal to promote cricket**

- The Big Cricket League (BCL), a franchise-based T20 event that will offer aspiring local players a chance to play alongside their cricketing heroes, has joined hands with the national broadcaster Prasar Bharati in a landmark long-term deal.
- The inaugural edition of BCL will be held in September this year in Lucknow.
- BCL will be broadcast live on DD Sports across the country, and Prasar Bharati will also be promoting the league across its network.
- The Big Cricket League's first season will be televised internationally in more than 30 countries. It will feature six teams, namely Awadh Lions, Northern Challengers, Rajasthan Kings, Mumbai Marines, Southern Spartans, and Bengal Rhinos.

#### **Gus Atkinson and Chamari Athapaththu crowned as Player of the month award for July 2024**

- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has revealed the recipients of the ICC Players of the Month awards for July 2024.
- England's Gus Atkinson and Sri Lanka's Chamari Athapaththu have been crowned as the standout performers in men's and women's cricket, respectively, for their exceptional contributions to the sport during the month.
- Gus Atkinson made an unforgettable entrance into Test cricket during England's ICC World Test Championship series against the West Indies. His remarkable performance played a pivotal role in England's comprehensive 3-0 series victory on home soil.

#### **Germany Captain Ilkay Gundogan announces International Retirement from Football**

- Germany captain Ilkay Gundogan announced his retirement from international football after leading his country at Euro 2024.
- Gundogan, who turns 34 in October, was in the Germany team that reached the Euro 2024 quarter-finals before losing to eventual champions Spain after extra time.

#### **ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024 moved to UAE from Bangladesh**

- The ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2024 venue has been shifted to the United Arab Emirates (UAE) from Bangladesh.
- The tournament will take place across the two venues in the UAE - Dubai and Sharjah - from October 3 to October 20 with no changes in dates of the scheduled matches.
- The BCB, however, will retain the hosting rights and stage the Women's T20 World Cup 2024 alongside the Emirates Cricket Board. Sri Lanka and Zimbabwe had also placed offers to take over as hosts.

#### **Diana Pundole: First Indian Woman Racer to Win National Championship**

- Diana Pundole, a mother of two and a teacher from Pune, has shattered the glass ceiling by claiming the national championship title in the saloon category at the MRF Indian National Car Racing Championship 2024, held in Chennai.
- She holds the distinction of being the first and only woman participant in the prestigious Indian Touring Cars mixed category, a fiercely competitive racing championship where most participants boast a minimum of 10 to 20 years of experience.

#### **Ronak Dahiya wins Bronze in U-17 Wrestling Championship**

- Indian wrestler Ronak Dahiya won bronze medal in Men's Greco-Roman 110 kilograms event at Under-17 World Wrestling Championship in Jordan.
- Dahiya defeated Turkish wrestler Emrullah Capkan 6-1 in the crucial medal match.
- With this, India has finished their campaign in Men's Greco-Roman category with two Bronze medals in the championship as Sainath Pardhi also secured Bronze in GR 51 kilograms category.

#### **Rohit Sharma & Virat Kohli honoured at the 26th CEAT Cricket Awards**

- The Indian men's cricket team captain Rohit Sharma was awarded the 26th CEAT International Cricketer of the Year Award at a ceremony held in Mumbai.
- Sharma was honoured for his exceptional performance in the 2023-24 season. Under his captaincy, India reached the final of the 13th ICC Men's ODI Cricket World Cup but lost to Australia.
- During this period, Rohit scored around 1800 international runs, including 597 runs during the 13th ODI World Cup.
- Virat Kohli, who had a terrific year in the One Day Internationals (ODI), was honoured with the Best ODI Batter of the Year award.

#### **Neeraj Chopra won silver in Lausanne Diamond League**

- Star Indian javelin throw athlete Neeraj Chopra registered a season-best throw of 89.49m at the Lausanne Diamond League 2024, in his first competitive appearance since he bagged silver for the nation at the Paris Olympics 2024.
- The 26-year-old was edged out by Grenada's Anderson Peters, who claimed the top spot in Switzerland with a mammoth throw of 90.81m. Julian Weber of Germany came in third on the day with a best throw of 87.08m.

#### **Shikhar Dhawan retires from all forms of Cricket**

- One of the finest One Day Internationals (ODI) batsmen in the world, Shikhar Dhawan has announced his retirement from all forms of cricket.
- His last competitive match was for Punjab Kings in the Indian Premier League (IPL) in April 2024.

#### **Lando Norris won Dutch Grand Prix**

- Lando Norris has won the Dutch Grand Prix to beat Max Verstappen in Zandvoort.
- McLaren's Norris continued his run of poor starts as he failed to keep the lead on a sixth successive occasion from the front of the Formula 1 grid, but passed Red Bull's Verstappen at the start of lap 18 before romping home to win by 22 seconds.

#### **India clinch silver medal at Asian Surfing Championships 2024**

- India won a silver medal at the Maruhaba Cup, a team event, at the Asian Surfing Championships 2024 at Thulusdhoo, Maldives.
- In the final, Japan won the gold medal by a substantial margin, with a score of 58.40 ahead of India, who recorded a score of 24.13. Taipei (23.93) and China (22.10) placed third and fourth, respectively.

#### **Shannon Gabriel retires from International Cricket**

- Shannon Gabriel of the West Indies has announced his retirement from international cricket.



- Since his West Indies debut in 2012, the right-arm quick played 59 tests, 25 ODIs and two T20 Internationals finishing with 202 wickets across the three formats.
- Gabriel was more successful in test matches and became a regular member of the West Indies team in 2017.
- He last played for West Indies in a test match against India in July 2023.

#### Avani Lekhara wins gold medal in para shooting at Paris Paralympics

- India's Avani Lekhara and Mona Agarwal won the gold and bronze respectively in the women's 10m Air Rifle competition.
- Avani bettered her previous record set in the Tokyo Games to finish at the top. She finished with a total of 249.7 to achieve the new Paralympic record in the category. Her previous best was 249.6 in the Tokyo Paralympics.
- Mona won the first medal for the country in the Paris Paralympics on her debut in the Games.

#### Aarti wins Bronze Medal in Women's 10000m race walk event at World U20 Athletics Championships

- In the World U20 Athletics Championships, Aarti won a Bronze medal in the Women's 10000m race walk event with the National U20 record time to open India's medal account at Lima in Peru.
- She clocked 44 minutes 39.39 seconds to finish third in the gruelling event on the penultimate day of competitions.

#### Women's Asian Champions Trophy 2024 to begin from 11th Nov at Rajgir

- Hockey India has announced that the 8th Women's Asian Champions Trophy 2024 will begin at Rajgir in Bihar on November 11th this year.
- The event, a joint effort between Hockey India and the Bihar Government, will take place at the Rajgir Hockey Stadium between 11th November and 20th November.

#### Dawid Malan retires from International Cricket

- Dawid Malan, England's former world No. 1 T20I batter, has announced his retirement from international cricket at the age of 37.

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch its Earth Observation Satellite-08 (EOS-08) on 15 August 2024, its 55th foundation day.
- The EOS-08 satellite will be launched by ISRO's Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV)-D3. Here, D stands for Developmental. The satellite will be launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.

#### India launches world's first mobile-launched hybrid rocket, RHUMI-1

- The world's first mobile hybrid rocket, RHUMI-1, was successfully launched. The successful launch of the RHUMI-1 rocket also marks the launch of the first reusable hybrid rocket in India.
- The rocket was developed by Chennai-based startup Space Zone India in collaboration with Martin Group.
- The success of RHUMI-1 is expected to improve the efficiency and reduce the operational cost of rocket launches, making space exploration more accessible.
- The RHUMI-1 rocket is launched from a mobile launcher like a special truck, and the rocket can be used again; hence, it is called a reusable rocket.
- The RHUMI-1 reusable hybrid rocket was launched from a mobile launcher in Thiruvudandhai, a coastal village in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

- **Breaking, Surfing, sports climbing, and Skateboarding are the four new sports** to be included in the 2024 Paris Summer Olympics.
- The United States, with 640 athletes, has the maximum number of athletes competing in the Paris Olympics, followed by host France, which has 608 athletes.

### Mascot and Motto of the 2024 Paris Olympics

- The 2024 Paris Olympics Mascot is Olympic Phryge. It is designed on the traditional French Phrygian hat that represents the symbols of freedom and the French Republic.
- It is coloured in blue, white and red, representing the flag of France with the golden Paris 2024 logo emblazoned across its chest.
- Alone we go faster, but together we go further," is the motto of the Paris Olympics and the Paralympic Games.

### About Indian Contingent in the Paris Olympics

- India has sent 117 athletes to the Paris Games, the **second-largest** contingent ever after the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, which saw the participation of 121 athletes.
- In the Paris Olympics, 70 male and 47 female Indian athletes are participating in the Paris Olympics.
- **Manu Bhaker and PR Sreejesh** were the Indian flag bearers at the **closing ceremony**.
- **PV Sindhu and Sharath Kamal** were the Indian flag bearers at the **opening ceremony**.
- **Out of the 32 sporting disciplines** in the Paris Olympics, India will participate in 16: Men's Hockey, archery, badminton, boxing, wrestling, equestrian, golf, athletics, tennis, judo, rowing, sailing, shooting, swimming, table tennis, and weightlifting.
